

Will of Nicholas McGinnis given on his deathbed.

Richmond County

Ebenezer Balderson, Zachariah White, and Silicia White this day appeared before me, John Belfield one of his Majesty's Justices of the peace for the aforesaid County made Oath that Nicholas McGinnis who died yesterday did in his last sickness in his own house give to his son Rich. McGinnis all his working Tools & the Timber in his Shop and that the aforesaid Nich. McGinnis did bid the aforesaid persons bear witness that the same was his Will Certified under my hand this 29 day of March, 1769.

John Belfield

At a Court held for Richmond County the 5th day of June, 1769 this Will of Nich. McGinnis was presented in Court by his son Rich. McGinnis and on the motion of the aforesaid Rich. was admitted to record.
