

Will Of Addison Thornton Dishman (1823-1895)

I Addison T. Dishman of the County of King George, Va, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do make and ordain this my last Will and testament in manner and form following –

Item 1st – That my body be buried as my wife or friends may direct.

2nd – That all my just debts be payed.

3rd – I bequeath to my wife Mary Jane Dishman all the remainder of my property, personal and real, for her use and benefit, during her life. And I further provide, that if she and my Executor, deem it best, it shall be her privilege to sell the property real and personal, and invest, the proceeds otherwise. She to have the interest only on the proceeds of sutch investment during her life – the principle at her death to be equally divided among – surviving children and grand children – the latter taking sutch share as they would take, if I had made no will.

4th – I appoint my son Charles H. Dishman, Executor of this my will, to greatify without security.

In testimony of this my last will and testament I hereby set my hand and affix my seal this 4th day of of August 1894.
