CASUALTIES AT GETTYSBURG.

We have received the following authentic lists for publication:

55TH VIRGINIA INFANTRY—COL. WM. S. CHRISTIAN COMMANDING.

Company A, 1st Lt Jno T Boughan commanding.—Killed: Privates R M Lumpkin and Jno Hardgrove.—Wounded: 1st Lt Boughan, right arm amputated; Corp E R Micou, severely in neck; Privates Ruffin Clarke, severely in mouth; Jno J Cauthorn, slightly in hand; A Crow, slightly in neck.

Company C, Capt R T Bland commanding.—Killed: Private W C Gardner. Wounded: Privates J A Owen, slightly in shoulder; A Greenwood, slightly in neck; T H Thurston, severely in hand and arm; A C Redwood, severely in arm.

Company D, 2d Lt Wm J Duff commanding.—Wounded: 2d Lt Duff, slightly in foot; 1st Sgt G H Taylor, slightly in back; Sgt Geo C Minor, severely through shoulder; Corp A J Gouldman, slightly in thigh; Privates Wm A Dunn, severely, and Wm T Greenwood, severely in thigh.

Company E, 2d Lt Wm E Baker commanding.—Killed: Private Jno J Gouldman. Wounded: 2d Lt W H Omohundro, severely in arm; Sgt Wilson Dishman, severely in chest; Corp Henry Horner, severely in hand and shoulder; Privates Benedict Jenkins, severely in arm; Thos S King, leg amputated; Jno R Omohundro, severely in hip.
