Grayson Pioneer Dies at His Home

J. W. Dishman, 88, pioneer ginner and businessman of Collinsville, Grayson County, died at his home Sunday following an illness of ten days. Born in Kentucky, he came with his parents to Texas as a boy. His parents

first settled in Tarrant County in the pioneer community of Bear Creek.
