

Death of Mrs. Mary J. Dishman.

KING GEORGE C. H., March 8.—Mrs. Mary J. Dishman, widow of the late Mr. Addison Dishman, of King George, died on Friday at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Boughton, in Essex county, where she was spending the winter. Her remains were brought from Tappahannock overland on Saturday and interred at the old family burying ground in the Edge Hill neighborhood, beside her husband and several children who preceded her to the grave.

The deceased was an earnest Christian woman and a devoted and active member of the Methodist Church. She reared a family of four bright, attractive daughters and seven noble sons, of whom one daughter and three sons have passed on before her across the river of death. Her remaining children are all married, and she is survived by a number of grandchildren and several great-grandchildren.

Mrs. Dishman was almost eighty-four years old.
